In the morning we'll take a narrated bus tour that includes the city of Honolulu, China Town, Iolani Palace, City Hall, King Kamehameha Statue, mission homes, and the Hawaii State Capitol building. We are currently making arrangements for a no-host lunch at Restaurant 604 in Pearl Harbor. Following lunch, we'll tour the battleship USS Missouri (The Mighty MO.), and then visit Pearl Harbor National Park. The Navy has agreed to provide a motor launch cruise around the USS Arizona memorial and Ford Island to cap the day. Then our tour bus will return us to the Hale Koa hotel.
